(Please bring a packed lunch – there are also shops that sell sandwiches nearby)

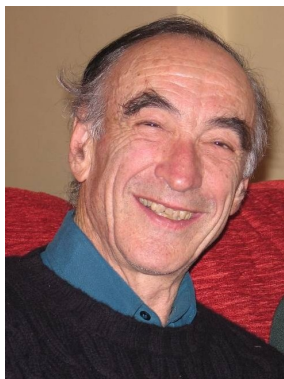
**Location: Willcox House, 140-148 Borough High Street, London, SE1 1LB**
